All a&o's are outfitted with a 24hr reception with snacks and drinks, and rooms in all categories.



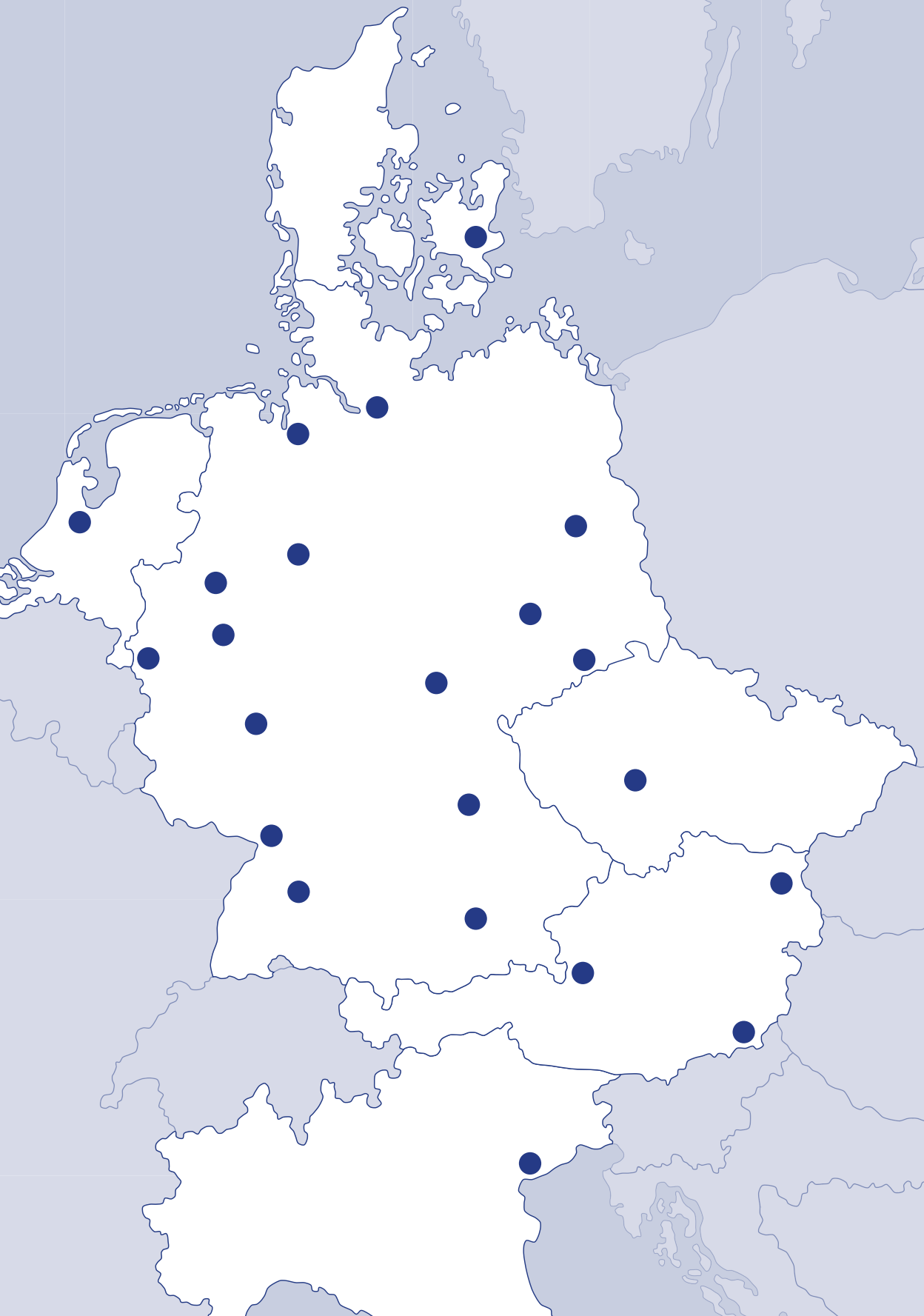

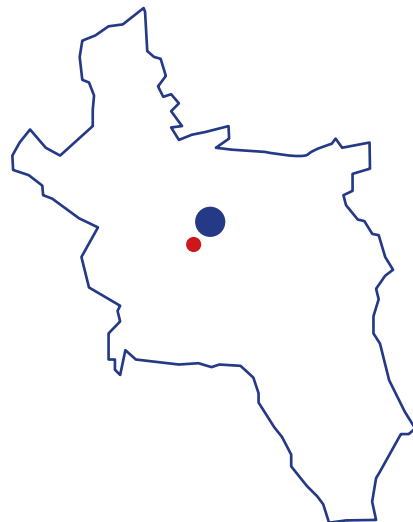


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# Aachen

It's easy to take the train there, which is why it's a good thing the a&o is located right next to Graz Main Station.



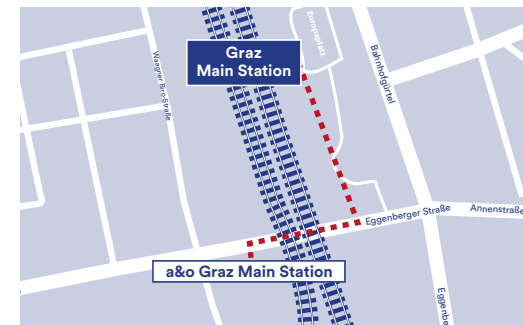

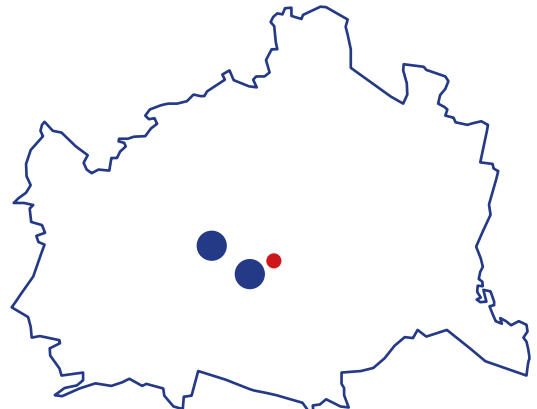


# Vienna

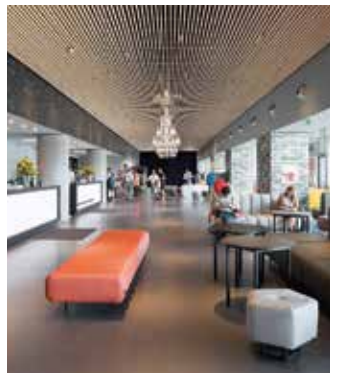


# Venice

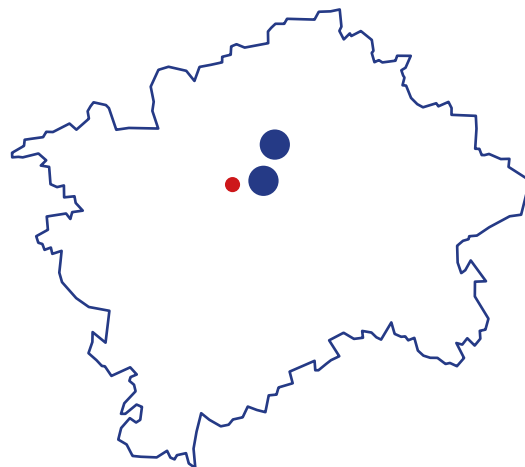


# Prague

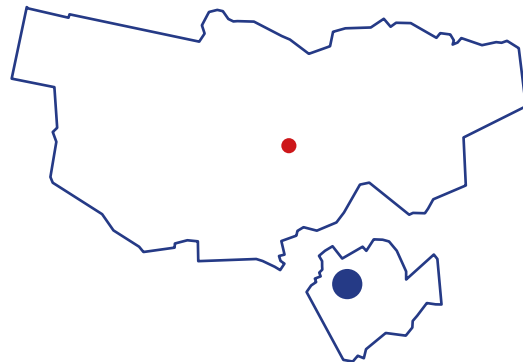

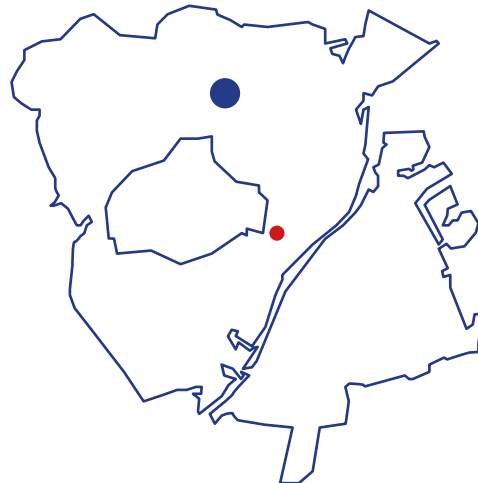

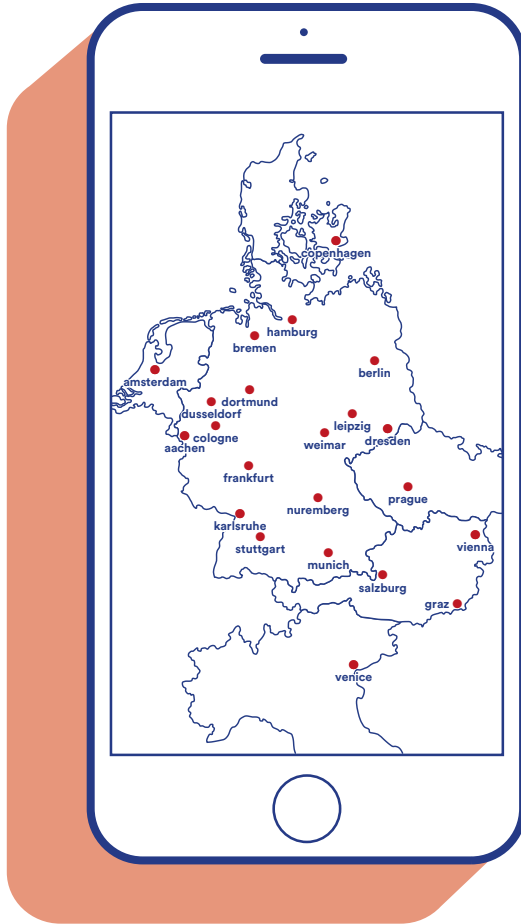
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
