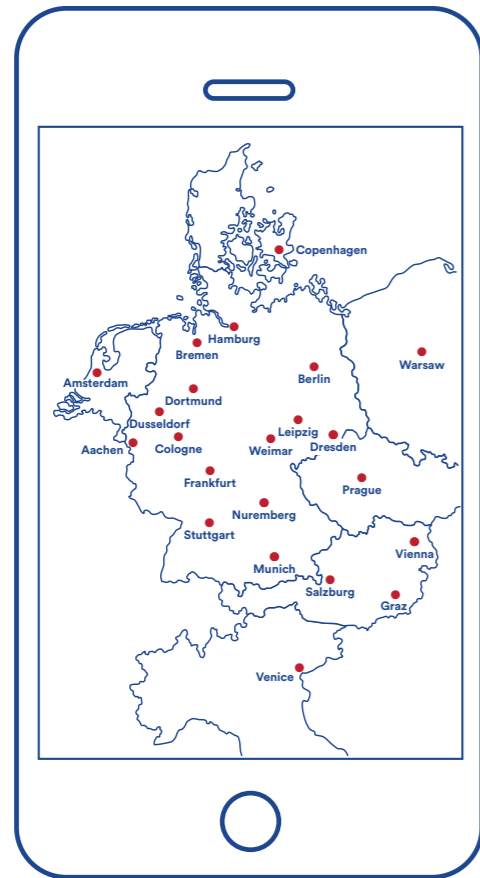

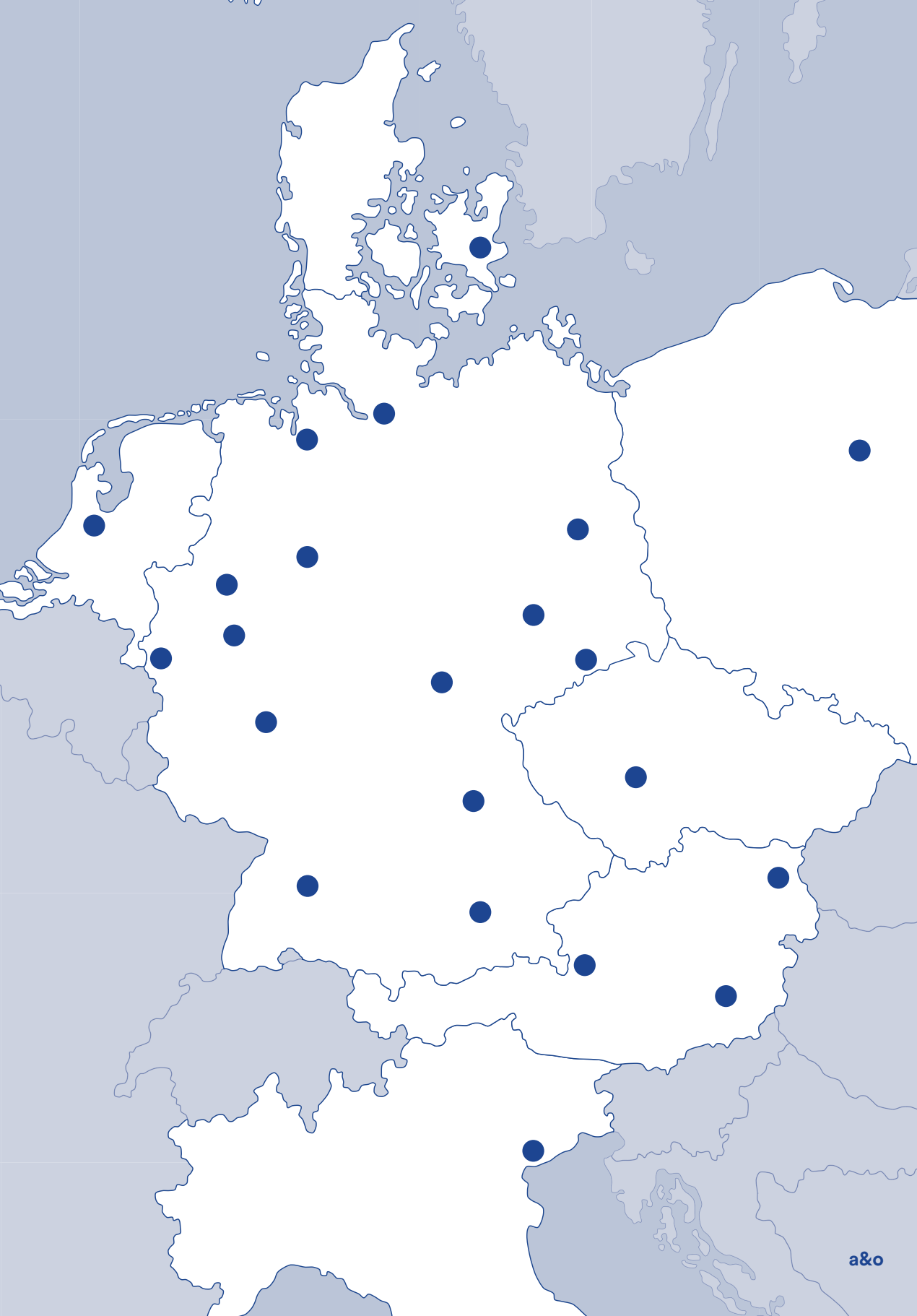

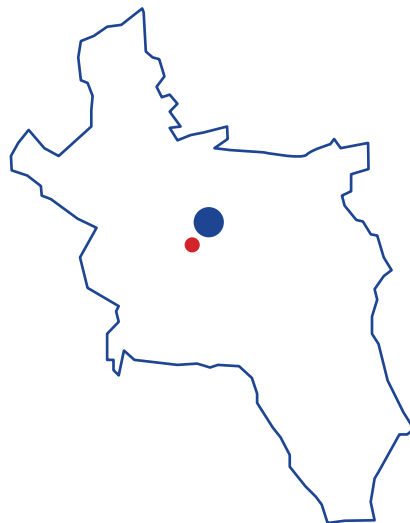

Aachen

Take a stroll, take a walk all the way to Belgium, or just take it easy: Aachen is a paradise for hikers, surrounded by green spaces in the border triangle with the Netherlands and Belgium. Did you know that Aachen Cathedral has been a UNESCO World Heritage site for over 40 years? It's definitely worth a look! Right next to it, the Münsterplatz invites you to linger among the magnolias; preferably while snacking on Aachener Printe, a type of gingerbread, and Reisfladen, a rice pudding pie.
